Lake Ain al-Sira is a naturally occurring lake that is visible from the museum grounds.

You will also enjoy an incredible visit to the Egyptian Museum, which is one of the first museums in the world to be established as a public museum. Unlike the museums that preceded it, the museum houses more than 180,000 objects, the most important of which are the archaeological collections found in the tombs of the kings and royal entourage of the Middle Dynasty at Dahshur in 1894, and the museum now houses the largest archaeological collection in the world expressing all stages of ancient Egyptian history.

You will finally enjoy a breathtaking excursion to Abdeen Palace, one of the most famous Egyptian palaces that witnessed a lot of events from the royal era to the establishment of modern Cairo, The palace is a rare historical masterpiece that reflects the grandeur with which it was built and the important events it witnessed from the royal era until the July 23 Revolution. It is considered one of the most important and famous palaces built during the reign of Muhammad Ali Pasha's family in Egypt and was the seat of government from 1872 to 1952.

The Museum of the Possessions of the Alawite family of Muhammad Ali Pasha, which includes objects of silver, crystal, stained glass, and other rare antiquities.

You start your day with an amazing tour of the Egyptian Museum, one of the earliest museums in the world to open to the public. The museum now has the largest archaeological collection in the world, representing all periods of ancient Egyptian history. It has more than 180,000 artifacts, unlike its predecessors. The most significant of these are the archaeological collections discovered in the tombs of the Middle Dynasty kings and royal entourage at Dahshur in 1894.

Your second destination will be the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization, located on 33.5 acres in the Fustat neighborhood of Cairo.
