Through huge columns, grand halls, and sacred lakes, you walk into an inundation of incredible craftsmanship of pharaohines and attestation of the magnificence of this ancient worship site dedicated to the god Amun-Ra.

Crossing to the West Bank of the Nile goes into the fabulous Valley of the Kings, where stately tombs were prepared for the New Kingdom pharaohs, including Tutankhamun and Ramses II. Intricate carvings and vivid wall paintings are; there are stories of the afterlife and the journeys of the soul, as well as some of the beliefs and rituals of ancient Egyptians.

Another high point on your excursion is the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, an architecturally splendid piece embedded within the Deir el-Bahari cliffs. As one among many of the more powerful rulers of ancient Egypt, the temple is testament to her reign as well as to the artistic innovation of the times.

Also featured on your tour, you will be a guest in the Colossi of Memnon, two gigantic stone statues that once stood guard as sentries in an entryway to a massive temple. These extraordinary figures remain in existence today, standing as silent witnesses for the immortal glory of Pharaoh Amenhotep III.

Luxor Tour from Safaga Port – Journey of Egypt's Timeless Wonders

Morning Departure from Safaga Port

You will begin with an early morning pickup from Safaga Port to start your adventure.

The pickup will be handled by a private, air-conditioned car. The journey to Luxor is memorable because it offers panoramic views of the Egyptian landscape, from desert terrain to the fertile lands of the Nile Valley, on which this entire exploration is based, to the one living ancient city of Egypt.

East Bank: Karnak Temple

Karnak Temple, your very first stop after entering Luxor, is one of the largest complexes of ancient Egyptian worship. Walk the Avenue of the Sphinxes; enter and behold one of the largest halls in the world, the Great Hypostyle Hall; eavesdrop on the stories of sacred obelisks, sharing tales of intimidating pharaohs and gods. Each stone out here speaks history inscribed with tales of victoriously swinging swords, offering gifts to temples, and divine affairs of rulers with gods.

West Bank: Valley of the Kings

Cross to the western shore of the Nile River and find yourself in the fabled Valley of the Kings, burial grounds for Egypt's great pharaohs. Inspect their burial chambers of richly decorated walls emblazoned with meticulously incised figures and bright panels of paintings illustrating the beliefs concerning the passage of the deceased into the afterlife. Worthy of noticing are the tombs' well-described walls and plans of the chambers painting old practices of burial.

The Magnificent Temple of Queen Hatshepsut

The next place to be visited should be the alluring Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, which magnificently lies within a pocket of steep rock cliffs at Deir el-Bahari. It represents the grandeur of the most powerful woman ruler of Egypt and is a shrine to her glory. Here you can examine the terraces, the statues, and inscriptions glorifying her achievements.

The Colossi of Memnon – Witnesses of the Days of Old

Before concluding any tour, an orientation visit to the Colossi of Memnon, two gigantic statues of Pharaoh

Amenhotep III, would have observed the changes in the Theban landscape for over three thousand years. That impression continues to resonate, even less so in present day, owing to the ravages of time- an iconic tribute to the grandeur of antiquity.
