On the way back, you will stop by the cozy town of Dahab. It is famous for its laid-back atmosphere, pristine beaches, and colorful bartering markets. After a leisurely seaside lunch at a top-pick restaurant, it's time to browse a selection of unique shops featuring handmade Bedouin crafts, silver jewelry, and traditional Egyptian trinkets.
