Day 1: Welcome to the Great Land of the Pharaohs:

Today, you will arrive at Cairo International Airport and be greeted by a helpful and expert Cairo Top Tours representative. They will assist you with all necessary and essential procedures at the airport. They will also help you meet the expert tour leader who will transfer you to one of the best and most beautiful hotels in Cairo.

Once you arrive at the hotel, they will help you check in quickly so you can get some rest and sleep to start your tour the next day with energy and vitality.

Day 2: Enjoyable Tour of the stunning Giza Pyramids, the dazzling Egyptian Museum, and Coptic Cairo:

You will have a refreshing breakfast at your hotel. You will meet your expert and specialist tour guide to visit many important sites today. You will visit the Pyramids of Giza, which are a marvel by any measure, as many phenomena still occur within the pyramid area that scientists are unable to explain. Astronomers have conducted further research and discovered that the pyramid's entrance passage points to the famous North Star Polaris, and the internal corridor points to the star Sirius. The pyramids were built in a very special location, located at the center of the world's five continents.

You will see the giant statue of the Sphinx and the spectacular Valley Temple of the famous King Khafre. The ancient Egyptians believed that the Sphinx, distinguished by its magnificent, legendary form, was built to achieve an important goal: to serve as a guardian of the tombs, temples, and huge pharaonic pyramids. Studies have confirmed that this majestic temple was built some time before the construction of the Sphinx. However, other hypotheses suggest that the construction of the Sphinx took place during the reign of King Khafre's brother, who attempted to control the country after the death of the strict and powerful King Khufu.

You will visit the iconic Egyptian Museum in the well-known Tahrir Square. The famous Late Period halls on the ground floor have been developed, housing the most important artifacts discovered from the Tuna el-Gebel area, most notably the rare and precious wooden coffin of Ba-d-Osiris. Finally, the treasures of Tanis have been re-exhibited on the first floor, where, for the first time, the artifacts of the powerful Silver King Psusennes are displayed in a separate hall. The artifacts of King Amun-em-Opet, King Shoshenq, and the accomplished army commander Wen-djeba-en-djed are also on display.

You will enjoy a tasty traditional Egyptian lunch. We will then visit the most important holy archaeological Christian sites and churches in Cairo. We will begin by visiting the Hanging Church, which gained great

significance as it was the first sacred papal seat in Cairo. The famous sixteenth Patriarch Christodoulos used it unofficially in the seventh century, continuing until the thirteenth century. This church has been the site of numerous apparitions and visions of the Virgin Mary.

You will also visit the sacred Church of Abu Serga, famous for its many vintage and scripture icons, the most famous of which is the icon of the arrival of the Holy Family, dating back to more than the ninth century AD. This church was formerly known as the Cave Church because this was where the Virgin Mary, Jesus Christ, and Joseph the Carpenter lived and took refuge when they fled Palestine during their holy journey to Egypt.

You will visit the ancient Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is the most famous synagogue in Cairo. Originally built as a church, it was sold due to high taxes. In this majestic temple, you'll find ancient libraries consisting of six cabinets decorated with distinctive ivory and mother-of-pearl, discovered in 1890. At the end of the tour, we'll take you to one of the most famous Arab markets, the Khan el-Khalil Bazaar, where you'll find all the unique Egyptian souvenirs and handicrafts you could be looking for. We'll transfer you back to your hotel after you've explored all these wonderful places.

Day 3: Exploration Tour of the Most Important Tourist Attractions in Bahariya:

You will visit the stunning Golden Mummy Tombs, discovered by Zahi Hawass's expedition. Approximately 250 priceless mummies have been excavated, unofficially estimated at around 10,000.

You will see the temple of Alexander the Great, which he built on his return from his trip to Siwa to seek the oracle to discover who had killed his father. This magnificent temple commemorates that visit. Under the Ptolemies, Bahriya grew rapidly, its economy flourished, and trade routes, particularly those leading to Libya, developed. Numerous military outposts were established to protect the country.

You will visit the old-standing Temple of Ain al-Maftila, which includes four beautiful and ancient shrines dating back to the famous Twenty-sixth Dynasty. This area was named Ain al-Maftila due to its proximity to a beautiful spring called Ain al-Maftila, located to the northeast of these ancient shrines. This spring is considered one of the most important and main natural water sources in the charming Bahariya Oasis.

You will pass by the ancient city of al-Qasr, which was located on the trade caravan route heading to the Maghreb. It was the ancient and important capital of the oasis and housed the massive palace of the oasis's main ruler, hence its name. The establishment of al-Qasr City as an important residential city predates the famous Islamic conquest of Egypt.

He decided to send a large military expedition led by the stern Captain Williams, who decided to build a military camp atop one of the Black Desert mountains, later called English Mountain, to monitor the Senussi forces that would periodically attack the oasis. After completing your visit to these stunning archaeological and natural sites, you will be transferred to one of the most comfortable hotels in Bahariya.

At night, the moon's rays reflect off its pure white land, creating a soothing, fluid landscape. Due to their unique composition, some of its rocks store the sun's rays during the day and re-emit them at night, in a complete and eerie replication of the moon itself.

You will see the perfect, shining Crystal Mountain, one of the most famous and beautiful mountains in the Western Desert. It boasts dozens of precious shapes and types of pure crystal. Surrounding it are thousands of beautiful crystal and glass pieces, glittering in dazzling colors. You will visit the famous Valley of al-Agabat, which tells the true story of this land's unique and long geological history. It also tells the fascinating human history of the region's inhabitants, as the valley contains many rare artifacts dating back to prehistoric times. There are massive ancient tombs and caves, the remains of priceless mummies and finely carved inscriptions, as well as the remains of ancient and beautiful houses from the Roman era and rare pottery, confirming that humans once lived on this land.

You will visit the Valley of El-Haiz and learn about the indigenous Bedouin population's most important customs and traditions, and hear their stories about how they lived in the past.
