Elephantine Island: From early times, Elephantine Island was of great importance as a commercial centre overseeing trade with the south, due to its location north of the Janadal region.

Then you will continue sailing to the Aga Khan Mausoleum In the heart of the high hills of Aswan and the golden sands of the mountains west of Aswan, a unique high building stands out in architecture that catches the eye of those keen to take a Nile tour during their visit to the country of fat, and this building is known as the "Aga Khan" mausoleum, where the body of Aga Khan III, whose real name is Sultan Muhammad Shata al-Husseini, lies.

You will continue on to the Kitchener Island Botanical Garden. Finally, you will sail back and be transferred to your hotel or Nile cruise in Aswan.
