You will see one of the most interesting temples at Philae Temple, which follows Greco-Roman architectural style, while the Unfinished Obelisk remains unfinished in the granite quarries; it was likely built for Queen Hatshepsut.

Your afternoon meal will be provided aboard the MS Nile Radamis Nile Cruise as you sail throughout the evening. You will spend your night with dinner service on your Nile cruise during your stay in this amazing city that also offers many things to do.
