Itinerary

Day 1 : Arrival

When you reach Cairo International Airport, our tour leader awaits to help you transfer to the hotel in Cairo while travelling in a personal air-conditioned vehicle.

The tour leader will help you with check-in while giving you full details of your Egypt Luxury Private Tours experience. Your guide will explain both your pick-up times and details about each exciting day tour of Egypt as well as Cairo sightseeing and your Nile River cruise experiences.

Overnight stay in Cairo.

Day 2: The Great Pyramids - The Egyptian Museum

Start your day by enjoying breakfast at your hotel, and soon after you will be met by your Cairo Top Tours Egyptologist guide, who will guide you to see extraordinary sites across Egypt.

At the Giza Plateau you will start your exploration, which features the Great Pyramid that King Khufu (Cheops) built during two decades as an engineering masterpiece. You will see three pyramids, including Khafre (Chephren) and Menkaure (Mykerinus), built during the time of King Khufu's successors.

Nearby, stand in awe before the legendary Great Sphinx, a powerful symbol of ancient Egyptian strength and wisdom with the body of a lion and the face of a king. The Valley Temple of King Khafre stands out through its combination of bright red granite and smooth alabaster surface, which began its journey from Aswan. The sacred establishment served an essential function in the royal process of mummification.

Your journey should lead you afterwards to the Egyptian Museum that offers an unmatched collection of ancient relics. Travellers can find the splendid funerary objects of King Tutankhamun which archaeologist Howard Carter discovered during his 1922 excavation in the Valley of the Kings. The institution provides visitors with exceptional access to the wealthiest historical chapter of Egypt.

In the evening spend your time at Khan El Khalili Bazaar, which is an active and vibrant marketplace located in Islamic Cairo. You can fully experience several attractions during a stroll through this maze of narrow pathways since you'll encounter mediaeval architecture and find opportunities to shop for various items. During your tour you will walk through El-Moez Street that contains several mosques along with historic buildings showing the lively Islamic culture of Cairo.

The day of touring ends with a guest transfer to spend the night at your selected hotel.

Day 3: Fly to Luxor - Luxor Sightseeing Tours

A delicious breakfast will start your day before the airport transfer to board your flight from Cairo to Luxor. Upon arrival in Luxor, our representative will welcome you before starting to explore the burial sites in the Valley of the Kings and proceed to the rock-cut tombs of New Kingdom kings.

Travel to El-Deir El-Bahari Temple to observe an architectural tribute built as a mortuary temple for Queen Hatshepsut despite her rare status as one of the few female pharaohs of Egypt. Admire the temple's unique design and dramatic location at the base of limestone cliffs.

Your trip continues to the East Bank of Luxor to witness the magnificence of Karnak Temple Complex. The great builders and priestly devotees of ancient Egypt will captivate you with their magnificent hypostyle hall along with massive statues and high-reaching obelisks.
