## Day 1 Friday: Check-in - High Dam - Philae Temple

Aswan Dam:

Before sailing, you will visit the Aswan <u>High Dam</u> which was built in 1960 to shield Egypt from the excessive floods occurring annually, in addition to providing the required electricity that suits a big country like Egypt.

#### Temple of Isis:

Resume Aswan excursions as you will visit <u>Philae Temple</u> and its astounding pillars and engravings which have been saved for thousands of years to tell us the <u>story of Horus and Osiris</u> and more about how great and advanced our fathers were. It was considered an important ancient center for the cult of <u>Isis</u>.

#### The Unfinished Obelisk:

Your <u>Aswan to Luxor Nile Cruise</u> extends to the granite quarries in Aswan to see the biggest obelisk in the world that is famous by the name the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, because the work was never finished and the obelisk was never used, Egyptologists believe that it was made by Queen <u>Hatshepsut</u>. After finishing at Edfu, the boat moves to Esna and finally heads to Luxor. Visitors to Luxor have the chance to see two of the greatest sites in Egypt, the Karnak Temple and the Luxor Temple.

You will be served lunch and dinner on the boat while you journey along the Nile. Late in the day, you have the opportunity to appreciate the illuminated and dramatic light show at Karnak Temple.

# Day 4: Valley of the Kings - Hatshepsut Temple - Colossi of Memnon

Local companies provide optional trips in Luxor, where you can take a hot air balloon tour very early in the morning.

After finishing breakfast, you will check out of the cruise ship and head with your guide to Luxor for a tour. See the Valley of the Kings, an incredible site in Luxor. Many consider the Valley of the Kings to be among Egypt's most famous sites of the past. The kings of the New Kingdom, as well as King Tutankhamen himself, were buried there.

Make sure to see the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, also called El Deir El Bahari. She ruled as the fifth pharaoh of Egypt's 18th dynasty and was one of the few women to do so. The Colossi of Memnon, two giant limestone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III, also stand here.

We will drop you off at either Luxor Airport or the train station before you leave.
