Giza pyramids:

The Giza Pyramids are located on the Giza Plateau in the Giza Governorate on the west bank of the Nile River. It was built about 25 centuries BC, between 2480 and 2550 BC. M. It includes three pyramids Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure.

Saqqara :

Sixteen other Egyptian kings built pyramids in Saqqara, in addition to some funerary monuments that were built by some senior officials in ancient Egypt. The area extending from the pyramids of Giza to Dahshur, passing through Saqqara, was classified as a world heritage site by UNESCO in 1979 AD.

Old Cairo:

The most wonderful landmarks of the ancient Egypt region, include the three monotheistic religions, Islam, Christianity, and Judaism, as it includes the Amr Ibn Al-Aas Mosque, which is the first mosque in Egypt and Africa and the fourth mosque built in Islam, and also includes the Church of the Virgin Mary known as the Hanging Church and a number of churches

Khan El Khalili Bazaar:

The neighborhood of Khan al-Khalili was a source of inspiration for many Egyptian writers and writers, most notably the writer Naguib Mahfouz, who wrote one of his novels that takes place in the neighborhood and bears his name “Khan al-Khalili”, which was turned into a movie starring the actor Emad Hamdy

Al Muizz street:

The street is currently the largest open museum of Islamic antiquities in the world, and a unique heritage site that was included in the list of World Heritage Sites in 1979 AD
