Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our English-speaking tour guide will transfer you to your hotel in Cairo.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara, Memphis

After breakfast, meet your personal Egyptologist guide and set off to see one of the most amazing places on earth. The <u>Pyramids of Giza</u> (Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus) and the <u>Great Sphinx</u> There, you will see all the ancient charm that the <u>Egyptian Pharaohs</u> had during the 4th dynasty of the old kingdom.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum, Cairo Citadel, Old Cairo, Fly to Luxor
