Day 1: Arrival at Cairo

Our tour guide will meet you at [Cairo international airport](#) and transfer you in a private car to your hotel.

Upon arrival at the hotel our representative will help you with the check in procedures and review your itinerary for your 15 Days Easter Holiday to Egypt 2023, and you will be served a welcome drink.

Overnight in Cairo.

Day 2: Day Tour to Pyramids and The pyramids of Dahshur

Have your breakfast at the hotel, then you will start your journey by visiting [the Great Pyramids of Giza](#).

The pyramid of Khufu contains over two million stones, each of which weighs approximately two and a half tons on average. And some of them weigh as much as 15 tons, while the weight of each of the roof tiles of the King's Chamber is 45 tons. The volume of the pyramid is about 89 cubic feet, and the total weight of its mass is estimated at over 6,840,000 tons.

Afterwards, you will have lunch with a view of the ancient pyramids.

Then we will move to Dahshur which is near the Giza pyramids. [The village of Dahshur](#) is an ancient royal necropolis located about 25 miles (40 kilometers) from Cairo. The necropolis is located in the desert on the west bank of the Nile.

Then you will be transferref to your hotel for your overnight there.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3: Museum of Civilization and El Refaai Mosque

After getting up and having your breakfast you will get ready for our next adventure

First, we will go and visit [The National Museum of Civilization](#) we will pass by The Temporary exhibition hall It covers an area of ??1,000 square meters and displays four crafts: pottery - wood - weaving - jewelry, and about 400 artifacts from different eras, in addition to a large number of heritage pieces, films and images that highlight the distinctive character of authentic Egyptian crafts.

Then you will have lunch in a traditional restaurant nearby the area.

And our tour will be continued to visit [Sultan Hassan El Refaai Mosque](#) The location of the mosque in the past was a market called "the horse market," according to what was mentioned, and it had a palace that Al-Nasir Muhammad bin Qalawun ordered to build for the residence of Prince Yalbugha Al-Yahawi.

Then you will back to the hotel to have your dinner and stay there.

Day 4: A Visit to Luxor

After having breakfast you will get ready to reach Luxor you will have some rest and check in at a hotel

Then we will go on a visit to [The Karnak Temple](#) The kings of the Thirtieth Dynasty used to approach God by adding buildings and facilities, erecting statues and obelisks, and presenting gifts and donations. When the place reached its extent of expansion, the kings erected their buildings on more than one side, and some kings removed the buildings of their predecessors to build their buildings in their locations.

And After this, you will move to [the Great Temple of Luxor](#) King Thutmose III set up booths for visitors to the holy trinity of Thebes, and Tutankhamun completed the inscriptions on its walls. The triple cabin that had been built before during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut and King Thutmose III was destroyed; Then it was rebuilt during the reign of King Ramses II. The temple is also called "Epet Reset". It is one of the best-preserved Egyptian temples and the most beautiful building, and in it the layout of the Egyptian temple is clearly evident.

and at the end, you will return to the hotel to have your lunch and enjoy the nighttime at Luxor.

Day 5: Luxor Attractions

Today and after having your breakfast you will visit the most famous attractions in Luxor at the beginning you will go to the valleys of Kings and Queen's first you will see [the Valley of Kings](#) The last burial chamber known as Tomb No. 63 was discovered in the Valley of the Kings in 2006, and two other entrances were discovered in 2008. The royal tombs are distinguished for containing drawings and inscriptions from ancient Egyptian mythology that illustrate religious beliefs and memorial ceremonies at that time .then you pass by [the Valley of Queens](#) It was known in the past as "Ta-Set-Nefru", which means "the place of the sons of the pharaoh" or "the place of beauty" because in this place the queens of the Pharaonic families were buried.

After that, you will get a break and have lunch surrounded by historical places.

Then you visit [el-Deir el-Bahari](#) Another king, Hatshepsut, preceded the establishment of his mortuary temple in that important area by about 600 years, and he is King Mentuhotep Nebhepetre (about 2055-2004 BC) from the Middle Kingdom, where he built his temple in a stepped form, from which Queen Hatshepsut borrowed the design of her temple.

and we will continue to reach [the Colossi of Memnon](#) The two statues embody King Amenhotep III as he sits on the throne with a low backrest, placing his hands on his feet and above him the royal crown. To the right of his legs there is a small statue of his wife, Queen "T", and to his left is a small statue of his mother "Mutt Um Wya", and on both sides of the throne there is an inscription representing the God of the Nile. The papyrus plant and the lotus (Delta and Upper Egypt) are linked to the symbol of each of them, as a sign of the unification of the country.

Eventually, you will back to the hotel to have some rest after this long day.

Day 6: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

On this day we will end our tour in Luxor by Visiting [The great temple of Edfu](#) The city of Edfu owes its fame to its temple, which is considered one of the most beautiful and complete Egyptian temples, as it is largely integrated with elements and replete with a huge number of scenes and texts.

then you will Visit [the temple of Komombo](#). and It is worth noting that the ancient Egyptian doctor was the first doctor who was able to perform a surgical operation on a living person, as he used to cut and remove pieces of the head bone, either by scraping or chisel. Among the very interesting information is that the ancient Egyptians were using a device called “Hemm” in order to open the abscess, and all these tools were kept in bags of leather, even medical texts were kept in those bags.

And all the meals breakfast, lunch, and dinner are included.

Day 7: Visit To Aswan Attractions

after having your breakfast and hot drink you will get ready to ride in our private air conditional cars to Aswan where you will see [The High Dam](#) The High Dam protected Egypt from droughts and famines as a result of the successive floods of scarce revenue in the period from 1979 to 1987 when approximately 70 billion cubic meters of the reservoir were withdrawn from the High Dam Lake to compensate for the annual deficit in the natural revenue of the Nile River.

then you will go to [the unfinished Obelisk](#) Although there is not much information available about the missing obelisk because it is an incomplete work, some opinions are based on the existence of a distinct purpose behind its carving of this enormous size to be the largest obelisk in Egypt. Where some opinions go that Queen Hatshepsut ordered the construction of the incomplete obelisk of this size to be evidence of its strength and solidity.

and we will end our tour in Aswan by having a sailboat to [the Nubian Village](#) The people of the village showed the world their culture, customs, and traditions, and most importantly, they preserved their Nubian environment in form and subject matter. To become the most enjoyable destination in all of Egypt

Then you will go back to the hotel in Luxor again.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner are planned in our program.

Day 8: Back To Cairo

After Checking out from the hotel you will ride our prepared cars to catch your flight to Cairo International Airport again to have some relief and rest there to start our next adventure tomorrow.

Day 9: Fayum Day Tour

Starting with some Egyptian breakfast you will get ready for the exciting day in Egypt, and the tour guide will accompany you during the tour.

In Cairo, get in a private van at your hotel. Drive leisurely 105 kilometers southwest of Cairo to Fayoum. An Egyptian city, the capital of Fayoum Governorate. It is divided into two residential neighborhoods separated by the Bahr Youssef Canal, which is in the middle of Fayoum. and when you reach you will start by visiting [Lake of Qarun](#) or the pond of Qarun is a lake in the city of Fayoum, Upper Egypt, located northwest of the city of Beni Suef, west of the Nile River, about 50 km away from it. Lake Qarun is located in Fayoum Governorate and is one of the largest natural lakes in Egypt. and you will know some of its histories.

You have a rest to get your lunch and continue the journey

Then the tour guide will take you to Wadi El Rayan Reserve is located in the southwestern part of Fayoum Governorate. Wadi El Rayan consists of the upper lake, the lower lake, the waterfalls area that connects the two lakes, the Uyun al Rayyan area south of the lower lake, and the Jabal al Rayan area, which is the area surrounding the eyes.

As your driver returns you to your hotel in Cairo, you completed your tour.

Day 10: Bahariya Oasis and The White Desert

After having your Breakfast in the hotel you will ride our private air conditional car to [Bahariya Oasis](#) Among the most important monuments in Bahariya Oasis are the tombs of the Twenty-sixth Dynasty, the cemetery of sacred birds, the remains of the Roman Triumphal Arch, the ruins of the Temple of Isis, and the ruins of a temple dating back to the era of Alexander the Great. It also contains the cemetery of the Valley of the Golden Mummies.

and we will continue to reach [The White Desert](#) It has a white color that covers most of its parts, and its total area is 3010 square kilometers. The White Desert is a protected desert and natural landscape, as it represents a model of the karst Kama phenomenon. It is considered an open museum for the study of the desert environment. and we will Camp there all night.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner all are prepared during the program.

Day 11: Return to Cairo

After this long remarkable night, you will back to Cairo to have a nice warm shower and spend the day in the hotel or in your room as you wish.

Day 12: Travel To El-Ain El-Sokhna

After getting your breakfast you will get ready to go to [El-Ain El-Sokhna](#) in our private comfortable car and after several hours we will Check in at [the Stella Di Mare](#) hotel and have some free time to do what you want.

Day 13: Snorkeling in El-Ain El-Sokhna
