Day 1 - Arrival

#### Day 2 - Cairo – Egyptian Museum & Great Pyramids

When you stay in Cairo, our tour guide will pick you up so you can enjoy an amazing trip to the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> (Cheops, Chephren, and Mykerinus). See the Great Sphinx and the Valley Temple, two historic sites, after that.

During the Pyramids, lunch will be served in the local café in Giza.

Next, go to the Egyptian Museum, It features a one-of-a-kind collection of almost 250,000 genuine artefacts that date as far back as 5000 years, as well as a special exhibition showcasing treasures from the Tutankhamun era. When his tomb was excavated in 1920, a variety of artefacts, gold, and jewellery that had been concealed there for more than 3,500 years were discovered.

## Day 3 - Nile Cruise - Aswan

Following consuming your breakfast at the hotel, you will go to Cairo Airport in a private air-conditioned vehicle to board your flight to Aswan. Our experienced guide will be waiting to greet you when you arrive at the airport. We'll transport you in a private vehicle with air conditioning.

The <u>Aswan day tours</u> will begin with the High Dam and continue to <u>the Unfinished Obelisk</u> and Philae Temple. You will be brought to the boat after the journey is over. The vessel will set sail towards <u>Edfu</u>. cruise overnight.

## Day 4- Nile Cruise - Edfu

After breakfast, our professional tour guide will meet you and take you away in a private A/C car. The Temple of Horus in Edfu will be the first site on your all-day journey. As the boat makes its way to Kom Ombo, where you can visit the temple that both the gods Sobek and Haroeies used, you will return to the ship and have your lunch. On a boat in the evening, you may participate in the Galabya party, a neighbourhood

#### Day 5 - Nile Cruise - Luxor East Bank
