Full-Day Nakhal and Rustaq Tour

Cairo Top Tours representative will pick you up at your hotel to start your wonderful Rustaq and Nakhal Tour to the southern governorate of al Batinah; The first stop will be the fish market "Seeb" on the way. The next stop is the Nakhal Oasis "Al Thowarah" where you can witness the source of the natural springs. Next, visit the Nakhal Fort. The most beautiful among the forts of Oman, the date by which the fort is back is not known however, it is believed to be a pre-Islamic building. the Fort houses a museum that now displays the ancient types of weapons controlled by the Ministry of Tourism .it also has a weekly goat souk.

After your tour in Nakhal, the journey continues to your next destination in the town of Rusatq. There you can visit another pre-Islamic fort as amazing as Nakhal, the fort of Al Rustaq. One of the highlights of the Rustaq fort is its four watchtowers: Al Burj Al Ahmar (the Red Tower), Al Burj Al Hadeeth (the Modern Tower), Al Burj Al Reeh (the Wind Tower), and Al Burj Ashiateen (meaning, rather, the Devil's Tower). These extraordinary structures will leave you speechless. Continue to other attractions in Oman, such as the Al Hazm Fort, about 20 km from Rustaq, which is one of the main attractions (photo stop). After taking many photos outside the fort, you will complete your visit to Rustaq and Nakhal and our guide will take you back to your hotel.
