Itinerary

Day 1: Get to Cairo, check in, and spend the night

The transfer to your awaited hotel is going to be done by our Cairo Top Tours tour leader, who will meet you at Cairo International Airport to help with the immigration formalities.

Then, you will arrive at the hotel in Giza, and upon arrival, you will be met by the tour manager, who will help you with check-in formalities.

They will also consult your Egypt Travel Packages itinerary to confirm that all the pick-up times are appropriate. Spend a night at this Cairo hotel, and you will be offered a welcome drink.

Day 2: Tour of the Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum, and Old Cairo

After breakfast, your English-speaking tour guide will meet you at the hotel to begin your tour of the Giza Pyramids. Visit the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, the Middle Pyramid of Chephren, and the Pyramid of Mycerinus. Explore the Valley Temple of King Chephren and marvel at the Great Sphinx.

Next, you will be transferred to the Egyptian Museum, where you can witness the extensive collection of Egyptian antiquities, including the golden treasures of King Tutankhamun. Continue with a tour of Coptic Cairo, visiting the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, the Hanging Church, the church of Abu Serga, and the Ben Ezra Synagogue.

Enjoy lunch at a reputable Egyptian restaurant. Explore <u>Islamic Cairo</u>, visiting famous mosques and the bustling <u>Khan El Khalili</u> bazaar. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 3: East Bank of Luxor Tour

After leaving your Giza hotel, head to Cairo International Airport to catch your flight to Luxor.

Our guide will meet you at the airport and help you begin your Nile cruise. Set out on the East Bank tour of Luxor after lunch on the cruise ship.

Take a tour of the magnificent <u>Temple of Luxor</u>, constructed under King Amenhotep III. Savor dinner and spend the night cruising the Nile.

Day 4: Edfu and the West Bank of Luxor

After breakfast on the Nile cruise, explore the West Bank of Luxor. Visit the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, the Valley of the Kings, and the <u>Temple of Hatshepsut</u> (El Deir El Bahari). Enjoy lunch on board as the cruise sails towards Edfu.

In the evening, savor an open buffet dinner and enjoy entertainment on board the cruise.

Day 5: Visit to the Temple of Edfu / the Temple of Kom Ombo

Start the day with breakfast on the Nile cruise. Visit the <u>Temple of Edfu</u> dedicated to the falcon-headed god Horus. Sail towards <u>Kom Ombo</u> and explore the unique Temple of Kom Ombo dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon-headed god Haroeris.

Enjoy lunch on board as the cruise continues to Aswan. Dinner will be served on board while watching the Nubian Show. Overnight stay on the Nile cruise in Aswan.

Day 6: Touring Aswan

See the <u>High Dam</u> of Aswan and the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which may have been built by Queen Hatshepsut, after breakfast on the ship. Savor dinner and a restful night on the Nile cruise in Aswan.

Day 7: Departure - Returning to Cairo

(Optional: Spend an early morning in the <u>Abu Simbel Temple</u>.) Check out of the Nile cruise after breakfast, then make your way to the <u>Aswan Airport</u> to catch your flight back to Cairo. You will be taken to your Giza hotel upon arrival. Savor a night spent in Cairo.

Day 8: Last Day of Travel

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the hotel and some free time. If you'd like, you can schedule more excursions to Cairo. After checking out of the hotel, make your way with your <u>Cairo day tour</u> to Cairo International Airport in preparation for your last journey.
