Day 1: Arrive to Cairo

From the airport, you will be transported to your hotel in a private, smoke-free, and air-conditioned car. Day 2: Tour to Giza Pyramids, Saqqara, and Memphis

After breakfast, you will be accompanied by a knowledgeable tour guide in the hotel lobby, embarking on our [Cairo Day Tours](#) to visit the Giza Pyramids, Memphis, and [Saqqara](#).

Our dedicated tour guide and driver will accompany you to the awe-inspiring landmarks of the Giza Plateau. Here, you will encounter the Great Pyramid of Cheops, as well as the pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus, all these structures were constructed during the Old Kingdom's 4th dynasty by Pharaohs. Your exploration continues with a visit to the Great Sphinx, a magnificent sculpture featuring the head of a pharaoh atop a lion's body. Additionally, you will have the opportunity to explore the [Valley Temple](#) of King Chephren.

For those seeking a unique experience, an optional 15-minute [Camel ride at Giza](#) is available (Optional activity).

Your journey will then lead you to other remarkable ancient pyramids, including the Step Pyramid of King Zoser, which is also known as the Djoser Pyramid, and the Teti Pyramid. Furthermore, you'll delve into the world of the nobles by visiting their tombs at Saqqara, where vivid paintings adorn the walls and corridors, offering a glimpse into ancient Egyptian life.

A delightful lunch awaits you at a local restaurant, followed by a brief drive to Memphis, located just 20 minutes from Saqqara. In Memphis, you will explore the open-air museum, housing a remarkable collection of statues and artifacts from ancient Egypt. Notable highlights include the alabaster sphinx, crafted from an 80-ton block of marble, and the colossal fallen statue of Ramses II.

As your day of exploration concludes, you will be comfortably transported back to your hotel for a restful night.

Day 3: Tour to The Egyptian Museum, Coptic and Islamic Cairo

You will savor a delectable lunch at a high-quality restaurant. Afterward, your journey continues to the [Coptic Cairo Tour](#), where you'll explore the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon and marvel at The Hanging Church, which is a prominent landmark in old Cairo. Additionally, you'll visit the church of St. Sergius, which is known as the Cavern Church which was built above the crypt where the holy family stayed for nearly three months. You'll also learn about the well from which the holy family drew water. Finally, you'll visit Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is believed to be the site where the pharaoh's palace stood and where the basket of Moses was found on the Nile.

Continuing your exploration, you'll dive into the charms of Islamic Cairo, where you'll uncover the remnants of medieval Cairo, including ancient walls, mosques, madrasas, sails, and city gates dating back to the Middle Ages. The stone-paved streets, preserved since the 10th century, add a unique ambiance to the experience. Your journey culminates with a relaxing tea break at Fishawy's, which is the oldest cafe in [Khan El Khalili](#), Cairo's historic bazaar.
