Day 1: Monday - Luxor East Bank Tours

the tour leader from Cairo Top Tours will meet you at [the Luxor Airport](#) or train station. After that, you'll board your Amwaj Living Stone Nile Cruise ship by a private, air-conditioned, non-smoking vehicle transport. After enjoying a leisurely meal on board, continue to unwind in your cabin.

Begin your Egypt Day Tours with a visit to [the Karnak Temple](#), which is regarded in ancient Egyptian mythology as the throne of Amun-Re, the Lord of Gods.

Following afternoon tea, your Luxor day tour continues with a visit to [the Luxor Temple](#), which was constructed remarkably near to the Nile River. After that, take in a two-hour oriental belly dance performance performed by a professional dancer from the area.

You will spend the night in Luxor and be treated to a delicious meal on your magnificent Egypt Nile River Cruise.

Day 2: Tuesday - Luxor West Bank Tours

Breakfast will be served on board in the early morning, after which you will embark on an educational Luxor West Bank Tour with your knowledgeable Egyptologist.

You will visit [the Valley of the Kings](#), learn about mummification and the New Kingdom's funeral customs, and then visit [the magnificent Queen Hatshepsut's Temple](#), the remnants of Amenhotep III's Temple on the west bank of the Nile, which is now known as [the Colossi of Memnon](#), and the female Pharaoh's temple, built by her loving architect, Senmot.

Following the completion of your Luxor tours, your Egypt Nile River Cruise will sail to Edfu. There, you'll have a delicious lunch buffet made on board, followed by tea served on the sun deck and a captain's welcome cocktail party later in the afternoon.

Spend the night in Esna and enjoy dinner on board while taking in the breathtaking scenery of the Nile.

Day 3: Wednesday - Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

After enjoying a delicious breakfast on the third day of your MS Amwaj Living Stone Egypt Nile River Cruise, we will begin [the Kom Ombo temple](#) and Edfu tour with a visit to [Edfu Temple](#), one of the most important ancient Egyptian temples that dates back to the Ptolemaic Era.

Because it is made up of two parallel temples, the construction is unique. The crocodile god Sobek was honored in the southern section, while [Horus](#) was honored in the northern. The two gods were intended to be worshipped at this temple. After seeing and having afternoon tea on board, there will be a ship lunch before setting sail for Aswan. After spending the night at Aswan, dinner will be served on board the ship.

Day 4: Thursday - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

You will enjoy Aswan day tours to see [the High Dam](#), the most significant accomplishment in Egypt's modern history, which is situated south of Aswan on the route to the airport, following your delectable breakfast on the Nile Cruise. After that, you and your private tour guide will explore the Granite Quarries region in order to view [the largest unfinished obelisk](#), which was most likely built by the well-known [Queen Hatshepsut](#), who governed Egypt during the establishment of the new country.

Eventually, we will take you on a traditional motorboat ride to continue your Aswan explorations. On this ride, you will see [the Temple of Philae](#), which was constructed in honor of the goddess of magic, Isis, who was the mother of the falcon god Horus. Built during the Ptolemaic era, it was moved to the island of Agilica during a salvage operation in the 1960s. Savor your midday tea and lunch on board.
