Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Check-In

Your 9 Days Egypt Wheelchair Accessible Tour to Cairo and [Siwa Oasis](#) itinerary will be revised to confirm all the pick-up times and if you would like to add any optional excursions in Egypt during your Cairo trips and Egypt desert safari adventure once you are met by a Cairo Top Tours representative at Cairo International Airport. They will assist you with the check-in procedures, transfer you to the hotel in Cairo, and confirm all the pick-up times for you.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour, Saqqara Necropolis, Memphis City

Following your first filling breakfast at the hotel, a representative from our company will meet you in the lobby to assist you with your Cairo day trips. Your first stop will be the fascinating tour of [the Giza Pyramids](#), where you will be astounded by the size of these enormous structures built during the old kingdom of ancient Egypt's history by [the greatest kings](#) and rulers.

You will see [the Great Sphinx](#) in Giza, a statue of a man with a body of a lion that is thought to have been made for King Chephren himself because it is located within his funerary complex, and then enter the Valley Temple where the king's mummification process took place as part of the burial process. This is all after having the option to ride a camel on the plateau surrounding the Giza Pyramids.

Saqqara tours are now your next stop to see [the Step Pyramid](#). This structure shows us the development of pyramid construction. It is the initial pyramid constructed in Egypt, and while it is not a 'true pyramid' with smooth sides like the Giza Pyramids, [the Bent Pyramid](#), or the Red Pyramid of Dahshur.

Continue your tours in Cairo by transferring to the place where the 1st capital of Egypt was, the ancient city of Memphis, you will see the open-air museum with the alabaster sphinx and the enormous statue of King Ramses II who ruled Egypt during the new kingdom era. You will have a tasty lunch in a good-quality restaurant overlooking the pyramids and the Sphinx before being transferred back to the hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3: Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo Tour, Khan El-Khalili

After completing your 2-hour tour of [the Egyptian Museum](#), you will transfer to the Coptic Cairo neighborhood to view the Christian heritage there, including the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, which was constructed atop two towers of the ancient [Roman fortress of Babylon](#), and the Church of St. Sergiu. Your private Egyptologist guide will meet you at the hotel after breakfast. Your trip to Cairo will begin there.

Enjoy your lunch in a good quality restaurant before being transferred to the [Islamic Cairo trips](#) district at Khan El Khalili to enjoy the best walking tours in Cairo and see the Egyptian local people very closely. After finishing your Cairo City Tour you will be transferred back to the hotel overnight.

Day 4: Cairo to Alexandria Day Trip

Prepare to meet your knowledgeable English-speaking Egyptologist to start your day tour from Cairo to Alexandria after enjoying a delicious breakfast at the hotel. We offer the best Egypt Wheelchair Accessible Tours. You'll ride in an air-conditioned vehicle as it takes you to [Alexandria](#). The journey takes about 2.5 hours to complete, including a stop for a break.

You will begin your tour of Alexandria, the city that Alexander the Great founded in 332 B.C., at Pompey's Pillar. You will then be taken to [the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa](#), and finally you will drive along the coast to the Citadel of Qaitbay, which was constructed over the ruins of the ancient lighthouse Pharos of Alexandria, one of the ancient seven wonders of the world.

Visit also [the Bibliotheca of Alexandria](#), which is a restoration of the earlier library that no longer survives. Ptomoly I constructed the library during the third century B.C. to be the center of science and knowledge in the world.

Enjoy your tasty seafood lunch at one of the best-quality restaurants in the city, overlooking the harbor, before being transferred to your hotel in Alexandria for check-in and overnight.

Day 5: Alexandria to Alamein, Siwa Oasis

After breakfast and check-out from the hotel, we will drive for about 7 hours to the stunning Siwa Oasis. En route, we will stop in the Alamein region to take [El Alamein tours](#), starting with the Military Museum and the Commonwealth Alamein Cemetery of World War II to view army models and learn about the main battle that took place in Alamein during WWII.

We will now move to the charming city of Marsa Matrouh to have our lunch meal at a delightful restaurant before continuing our tour to [Siwa Oasis](#). Upon arrival, we will leave our baggage in the eco-lodge and transfer to one of the most pleasant natural hot water springs in Egypt to take a bath that will calm our muscles after a long day's drive. Back to the hotel and overnight.

Day 6: Siwa Sightseeing Tours

Enjoy your breakfast of [Egyptian cuisine](#) in the Eco-Lodge before beginning your Siwa Oasis tours. While there, take time to explore the ruins of the Shali Fortress, where the ancient Siwan people sought refuge from the threat of raids from outsiders. After that, you will be taken to see the 26th-dynasty-era Temple of the Oracle in Aghurmi Village, as well as the Temple of Um Ubeyda and another temple honoring Amun Ra. You will also learn about the priceless Siwan heritage during your visit to the Siwa House Museum, and lunch will be served at one of the Oasis's lovely restaurants.

You will spend a leisurely afternoon at [Cleopatra Spring](#), one of the most well-known hot springs in Siwa Oasis, which is thought to have been used by Queen Cleopatra, the last pharaoh. Enjoy swimming and dipping into the sparkling water before being transferred to Fitnas Island to take in the picturesque sunset view.

Day 7: Egypt Desert Safari Tour to the Great Sand Sea

You will have a nice breakfast at the hotel before continuing your Siwa Oasis Desert Safari, your certified Egyptologist will take you in a 4x4 vehicle to explore to the Great Sand Sea. Before moving on to the lovely sand dunes and the fossilized corals from the Cambrian era, we will start our Egypt Desert Safari adventure by visiting [the Mountain of the Dead](#) and many of the tombs of the oasis' rulers. Then, we'll take you to one of the amazing locations in the Great Sand Sea, a stunning lake in the middle of the desert, where you might be lucky enough to see flamingo birds appreciating the tranquility of the desert and bathing in a very calming mood.

After passing by the Dakroul Mountain, we will now enjoy sandboarding, which gives us the thrill of gliding down sand dunes rather than snow. After snowboarding, it is time to wash up in the hot spring known as Bir Wahid to relax our muscles. We will then take in another breathtaking sunset at the end of the Great Sand Sea Tour while drinking Bedouin tea in the middle of the dunes.

Overnight in Siwa after being transferred back to the eco-lodge.

Day 8: Back to Cairo

Early in the morning, before departing from Siwa Oasis via Marsa Matrouh for Cairo, you will have your breakfast box. You will be taken to your hotel for the night in Cairo after arrival. If you're fortunate and we arrive back in Cairo earlier than expected, you can reserve one of the things to do in Cairo by night, such as a belly dancing and Tanoura dance performance while dining on an optionally entertaining Nile cruise while on a sailing boat on the Nile River.
