Itinerary

Day 1: Check in- at Luxor East Bank

Our agent will greet you at the Luxor airport, railway station, or hotel. Then, in a private air-conditioned car, you will be transferred to Sanctuary Sun Boat III.

Begin your [Egypt day trips](#) by discovering Luxor's east bank, where our tour guide will take you to the most famous temple, the [Karnak temple](#) complex, one of the greatest structures ever built in human history and considered the earthly home of the [god Amun Ra](#). Following that, you will see Luxor Temple, which was begun by one of the 12th Dynasty monarchs and completed by King Ramses II.

The existence of Islamic and Coptic art alongside ancient Egyptian art will be discovered during your tour of the Luxor temple. The Islamic art will be discovered while visiting the mosque of Abu el Hagag, which was erected on the ruins of the Coptic church.

On board, lunch will be served. After finishing your Nile cruise for the day, you will be transferred to your ship to rest and refresh. The personnel will put on an Egyptian folklore display in the evening. Dinner will be served, and you will spend the night in Luxor (L-D).

The Karnak Sound and Light Show is offered if you wish to see the beauty of this ancient site at night!

Lunch and dinner are included in the price.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank - Sail to Edfu

Our tour guide will drive you to the [Luxor west bank tour](#) after breakfast on the Sanctuary Sun Boat III Nile cruise, where you will view the Valley of the Monarchs, which is the royal cemetery of the Theban monarchs and rulers of ancient Egypt, as well as the burial location of our pharaohs. Following that, you will see Hatshepsut's temple at El Deir El Bahari, the most spectacular example of ancient Egyptian architecture, as well as the [Colossi of Memnon](#), which are two massive stone sculptures belonging to [King Amenhotep III](#). The Colossi of Memnon were already a prominent tourist destination throughout the Greco-Roman period. Return to your Nile cruise for dinner and spend the night onboard for free at Luxor.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are all included.

Day 3: Edfu - Kom Ombo Temple

The Sanctuary Sun Boat III departs from the Nile cruise after breakfast. To see the wonders of the old city, our tour guide will take you to the Temple of Horus in [Edfu](#), one of Egypt's best-preserved ancient monuments. You will then be returned to your ship. Lunch will be served on board while sailing to the city of Kom Ombo. Discover the [Kom Ombo temple](#), where the two gods Sobek and Haroeris were once worshipped. Dinner will be served on board while the ship cruises towards Aswan. Arrival at [Aswan](#) in the evening, followed by an overnight stay.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are all included.

Day 4: Aswan Tour

Breakfast will be provided on the Sanctuary Sun Boat III Nile cruise, followed by a tour guide-led visit to the [High Dam](#), the Unfinished Obelisk, and The Great [Philae Temple](#), also known as the Temple of Isis, is an awe-inspiring ancient Egyptian temple complex located on the island of Philae in the Nile River near Aswan dedicated to the [Goddess Isis](#), was the final completed temple in classical Egyptian architecture. Work started around 690 B.C. When the tour is finished, you will return to your boat. Lunch will be served on board, as well as afternoon tea. Tonight is a free night. You will have dinner and spend the night on your own in Aswan.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are all included.

Day 5: Disembarkation - Departure to Cairo

Departure after breakfast. After that, our agent will accompany you to [Aswan airport](#) - Aswan station, where you will board your domestic aircraft to Cairo.

Breakfast is included.

Optional excursion: Private bus or domestic flight to [Abu Simbel temples](#), Our guide will meet you in Aswan and drive you by private A/C van to Abu Simbel, in what was once Nubia. You will see Abu Simbel's temples upon arrival. The Great Temple is the most massive of the temples. It was built by [Ramses II](#) and is dedicated to the mythological god Rahorakhty. In the smaller temple, King Ramses II and his beautiful wife, [Queen Nefertari](#), were honored.

Following your visit, you will depart for Aswan and be driven by a private air-conditioned vehicle to your preferred hotel for check-in, rest, and refreshments, or to Aswan airport for your domestic flight to Cairo.
