Day 1 - Arrival Cairo- Cairo Day Tour

Your tour will start at [the Giza pyramids](#) once our Cairo Top Tour agent picks you up from the airport.

One of the few remaining wonders of the ancient world is the Giza Pyramids, which are situated on the Giza Plateau, where you will first arrive.

You tour the Pyramids and take in the panoramic views from the western plateau before making your way down the valley to the colossal [Sphinx](#), who proudly serves as the Mortuary complex's watchman.

The next stop is one of Egypt's most significant government papyrus institutes, where you can select from a variety of hand-painted papyrus sheets and see a demonstration of the process used to create this ancient paper. This location is close to the pyramids.

Discover a fantastic Cairo the fascinating labyrinth of streets and booths in the old city, as well as the breathtaking Old Cairo attractions.

Visit Old and [Coptic Cairo](#), where you may see the Hanging Church, [the Ben Ezra Synagogue](#), the Church of St. Barbara, and the Church of Abu Serga, among other significant Cairo landmarks. These are all significant historical sites that can be visited to learn more about ancient Egyptian culture.

Our break will include lunch at a restaurant in Old Cairo. This will allow us to discover this unique area of the city.

For more than 1400 years, [Khan el-Khalili](#), a historic marketplace in Cairo, has served as the hub of trade. It's a perplexing maze of roads with intriguing findings and treasures. This is the spot to go if you're seeking for something exceptional.

For the evening, a transfer will take you back to your accommodation.

Day 2 - Fly to Luxor- Luxor Museum & Mummification Museum Tour

The tour guide will get you up from the hotel after you finish eating breakfast, assist you with checking out so you can take the flight from Cairo to Luxor, and then transfer you to your hotel in Luxor so you can unwind before our journey starts.

After the Cairo [Egyptian Museum](#), the [Luxor Museum](#) is the second-most visited museum in the nation. We will pick you up from your accommodation in Luxor and take you there.

This museum features a sizable collection of artifacts culled from digs at numerous historically significant sites all around the area. Highlights include the statue of Thutmose III, Tutankhamun's personal goods, jewelry, pottery, sculptures, and stone tablets from the [Luxor Temple](#) and Karnak temples. This is a wonderful chance to view some of the most important works of Egyptian art.

The Mummification Museum, which is under the direction of the god Anubis, is our next site. You will learn about the unusual mummification rite and its 70-day procedure in this museum. You will also learn about the history of the tools used and the social marginalization of people who worked on the remains. It was started back in 1997.

We will transport you back to your hotel following this instructive historical presentation.

Day3-Luxor West Bank

Your [Luxor day Tour](#) will begin with breakfast, after which our tour guide will pick you up from your accommodation and bring you on a short drive to the West Bank of Luxor. Your first visit will be [the Valley of the Kings](#), Thebes' Necropolis, which is situated on the West Bank of Luxor. Visitors to Luxor must see this historic necropolis. Under Thebes Mountain, there are graves that make up this area. Three graves from several dynasties are open for visitors to investigate here. The best tombs to visit may be suggested by your Egyptologist tour guide. You'll be taken to [the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#) after touring the tombs. The Colossi of Memnon, the two largest ancient sculptures in Egypt.

Day4- Day Trip to Edfu and Kom Ombo from Luxor

We will leave today after breakfast and travel to Kom Ombo and [Edfu](#). You can see the Temple of Kom Ombo in [Kom Ombo](#), which honors the crocodile god Sobek. After this stop, you continue on your way to Edfu. You'll be taken to the Temple of Horus to witness the god with the falcon on his head. This recently constructed pharaonic temple has been kept up nicely and is therefore pretty magnificent. We'll take you to your hotel in Aswan in the evening so you may check in and possibly spend the night there.

Day5- Aswan High Dam and The Abu Simbel Temple

After a delectable breakfast in the hotel, our tour guide will take you to see some of Aswan's attractions.

Aswan [High Dam](#), an embankment dam constructed in Aswan, Egypt, that crosses the Nile, has been known as the Aswan Dam since the 1960s.

The Aswan Low Dam, which was built earlier and further upstream in 1902, was much less significant than this one.

Following the 1952 Egyptian Revolution, the government made building the High Dam a top priority due to the Low Dam's success, which was then being utilized to the fullest extent. It was believed that the dam's ability to produce hydropower, store more water for agriculture, and enhance flood control would be crucial to Egypt's planned industrialization.

The High Dam has had a tremendous impact on Egypt's economy and culture, much like its earlier construction. then stop at a local restaurant for lunch.

After that, take an air-conditioned minibus from Aswan to Abu Simbel. The two temples of [Abu Simbel](#) are regarded as the best representations of ancient Egypt because of their distinctive structure. They serve as examples of the splendor and majesty of the upcoming Kingdom. The Egyptian government and UNESCO resolved to work together to safeguard these sites from inundation. Ptah, Re-Her-Akhtey, Amun-Re, and Ramesses II all had temples in their honor. The enormous Abu Simbel temple is also known as the Sun Temple of Ramses II.

Ramesses II, Hathor, and the Sun God are symbolically united at the Temple of Queen Nefertari, also referred to as the Temple of Hathor because she was the Sun God's wife. Spend about three hours there before returning to your Aswan lodging for the evening.

Day 6- Visit Philae Temple and fly to Cairo

Check out after breakfast, and our tour guide will take you up to visit after that. One of Egypt's most exquisite temple complexes is [the Philae Temple](#), Take a water taxi to the island of Aglika to go to the ruins, which are just south of the former Aswan Dam. When the High Dam was built and threatened to sink it forever, the temple was moved to its current location. The complex's original layout and design were precisely preserved when it was painstakingly reconstructed in its current location. Even the island's landscaping was done to replicate the complex's previous setting. As the focus of Isis' worship during the Ptolomaic Dynasty, Philae gained fame.

When your excursion is over, you will be dropped off at the [Aswan airport](#) so you can catch your flight to Cairo. Receive transportation to your hotel in Cairo after your arrival, where you will spend the night.

Day7- Bahariya Oasis Safari Tour

Our tour guide will pick you up from Cairo today to begin our [Bahariya Oasis](#) Tour. After strolling through the historic village, traveling to the [Black Mountains](#), and stopping at the salt lake, you'll continue your Oasis Tour by visiting the renowned Mummies Hall, The [Golden Mummies](#), and [the temple of Ain El Muftella](#), After lunch, you will be taken back to your Cairo hotel for the evening as part of your Oasis Tour, which will be led by an English-speaking tour guide.

Day 8- Alexandria Ancient Adventures

After a delicious breakfast, you will be picked up by one of our representatives to explore the important Greco-Roman remains in Alexandria and discover more about the city's historic past.

The spooky [Kom el Shoqafa Catacombs](#) can be reached after viewing the Serapeum, a temple that houses [Pompey's Pillar](#), a red granite column. The perfectly restored Roman amphitheatre and the adjacent mosaics

are not to be missed.

next proceed to the water where you may feast on a variety of Mediterranean seafood.

Next, check out [the Citadel of Qaitbay](#), a 15th-century sea fort that stands where the old Lighthouse of Alexandria once stood.

You may travel back in time to the ancient world thanks to the underwater archaeological exhibitions at [the National Museum of Alexandria](#). The outcome On a tour of the city's street foods, discover the diverse world of Egyptian cuisine, which draws inspiration from Ottoman and Arab traditions. Koshary, a spicy dish made with lentils, noodles, and sour tomato sauce, as well as kebabs, mixed grills, meze dips, and shellfish, are some of the delicacies to try. then drive you to your hotel in Alexandria so you can check in and stay the night.

Day 9- Alexandria Modern Magic- Back Cairo

Following your hotel check-out, our tour guide will pick you up in the morning.

The Great [Library of Alexandria](#) served as the epicenter of learning for most of antiquity. Start the day by visiting the stunning replacement Alexandrian Library. Next, go to two of Alexandria's most well-known mosques: the Nabi Daniel and [the Abu al-Abbas al-Mursi mosques](#),

As you arrive at the Stanley Bridge and Montazah Palace Gardens, continue biking down the corniche. We'll go to Cairo in the evening, drop you off at your hotel, and then spend the night there.

Day 10- Final Departure

After finishing your breakfast at the hotel, you will return by air-conditioned car to the Cairo airport for your final departure flight.
