Itinerary

Day 1: Friday - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

Following lunch, you will embark on your [Aswan Day Tours](#), starting with a visit to the renowned [High Dam](#) in Aswan. During your excursion in Aswan, you will also be transported to the granite quarries that supplied ancient Egyptians with the necessary stone blocks for constructing magnificent pyramids and temples. Here, you will witness the [Unfinished Obelisk](#), believed to have been carved during the reign of the influential Queen Hatshepsut in the New Kingdom of ancient Egypt. Next, your driver and guide will accompany you to visit one of the most exceptional ancient Egyptian landmarks, the [Temple of Philae](#), also known as the Temple of Goddess Isis. Situated on an island, you will have the opportunity to sail on the Nile to reach this extraordinary temple.

Day 2: Saturday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

On the second day of your Nile River Cruise, you will begin with a delicious breakfast on board. The day's adventure will take you to [Kom Ombo](#) and Edfu. You will sail towards Kom Ombo, where you will discover a unique and extraordinary double temple.

After exploring Kom Ombo Temple, you will continue sailing towards Edfu, enjoying lunch on your luxurious Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor. Once you arrive in Edfu, you will be escorted to visit the impressive [Edfu Temple](#). In the evening, you will enjoy a delightful dinner served on the cruise ship. As you sail towards Esna, you will have the opportunity to attend an Egyptian Galabeya Party. The Galabeya is a traditional one-piece long dress worn by both men and women in Egypt. Day 4: Monday - Luxor Last Day

Once there, you will visit the magnificent [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#) (El-Deir El-Bahari Temple) and choose three tombs to see from the inside in the [Valley of the Kings](#). The first undiscovered tomb following the discoveries of Queen Hatshepsut's Temple and Tutankhamun's Tomb (El-Deir El-Bahari).

You will finally pause so that you may see the enormous statues of Memnon.
