Day 1: Luxor East Bank Tours

Continuing your Luxor excursions, you'll be transferred to the enchanting [Luxor Temple](#), located in the heart of the city that shares its name.

For an additional option, you can also experience the mesmerizing [Sound and Light Show in Karnak Temple](#). Meals provided include lunch and dinner.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank Tours

Day 4: Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

After breakfast on the [Egypt Nile cruise tours from USA](#), meet your private tour leader for the [Aswan day tours](#):

The High Dam: Explore [the High Dam](#), a crucial structure that protected Egypt from Nile floods, preventing water wastage. Aswan, located at the southernmost point of Egypt, is about a thousand kilometers away from Cairo.

The [Unfinished Obelisk](#): Visit the granite quarries where ancient Egyptians cut and transported granite for pyramids, temples, and obelisks during the old and new kingdom eras.

Philae Temple: Continue your Aswan tours at [the Philae Temple](#), a Greco-Roman-style monument dedicated to the worship of Goddess Isis. It holds significance in the legend of Isis, Osiris, and Horus.

After the tour, return to the cruise for lunch and enjoy free time in Aswan. In the evening, savor a quality dinner on board, followed by an entertaining Nubian show. Overnight in Aswan.
