It measures about 42 meters (137 feet) in length and would have weighed around 1,200 tons if completed, making it one of the largest obelisks ever attempted to be constructed.

Continuing your journey, you will explore the [Philae Temple](#), situated on the picturesque island of Philae. This temple, often referred to as the "Pearl of Egypt," is renowned for its remarkable beauty and historical significance. Dedicated to the goddess Isis, it showcases stunning architecture and intricate carvings.
