Day 1: Kasr Ibrim Citadel

Cruise to Kasr Ibrim; the tour is given from the ship deck because it is not allowed to enter the site. Keep going to [the Amada temples](#); they were built during the 18th Dynasty. [Kings Thutmose III](#) (c. 1479–1425 BC), Amenhotep II (c. 1427–1400 BC), and King Thutmose IV constructed the temple's central structure. Derr & Penout Tomb: This type of tomb is carved out of rock. It is comprised of an antechamber, followed by a niche containing the ruins of three damaged statues. Sail to Wadi El Seboua in the afternoon to explore the temples there as well as Dakka and Meharakka.

Dinner and overnight on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner!

Day2: Wadi El Seboua

Enjoy a delicious breakfast on board the Aswan cruise, followed by a cocktail at the Tropic of Cancer. Enjoy lunch on board, then visit [the Kalabsha temple](#), Bet El Wali, and [the Kiosk of Kertassi](#), which is an ancient Roman relic saved from destruction by the Aswan High Dam.
