After exploring <u>Lake Qaroun</u> and Wadi El Rayan, you will travel back to Cairo, where you will spend the night.

For the day, your meals will include breakfast and lunch. Enjoy the scenic beauty, the diverse wildlife, and the tranquil atmosphere of Lake Qaroun and Wadi El Rayan during your visit.

This substance forms the distinctive black landscape of the Black Desert. The English Mountain, which is the highest peak in the Black Desert, adds to the scenic beauty of the area.
