Day 1: Arrival day

On your first day, our tour guide will meet you at the [Cairo international airport](#) and transport you to your Cairo hotel in an air-conditioned car. We will help you with all check-in processes and will go over your itinerary with you to confirm all pick-up times and the itinerary of your trip.

You have the remainder of the day to prepare for tomorrow, or we may provide some optional activities to assist you.

Day 2: Giza pyramids and Egyptian Museum

After take your breakfast, start your day with the [Pyramids](#) of Giza and the Great Sph are some of the most famous iconic structures in world, and are a must-see on any trip Egypt. Located on the outskirts of Cairo, these ancient pyramids were built as tombs for the [pharaohs](#) and their consorts, and are believed to have been constructed around 4,500 years ago. The [Great Sphinx](#) is a massive stone statue of a mythical creature with the body of a lion and the head of a human.

After exploring the pyramids and the Sphinx, take your traditionally lunch, then head to the [Egyptian Museum](#) to see ancient artifacts and treasures. The museum is home to the world's largest collection of Egyptian antiquities, with over 120,000 items on display.

Meals: breakfast & lunch.

Day 3: Coptic Cairo tour

We will transport you to [Coptic Cairo](#) after breakfast. There, you will get the opportunity to tour three of Egypt's most unique churches: the Hanging Church, the [Ben Ezra Synagogue](#), and Abu Serga. We will eat traditional lunch at a local restaurant after viewing these churches, and if time allows, we will visit [Khan El-Khalili](#) and sip traditional tea at Al-fishawy cafe.

Meals: breakfast & lunch.

Day 4: Wadi El Natrun & travel to Alexandria

On the fourth day, after breakfast, we will leave Cairo early in the morning for the [Wadi El-Natrun](#) Monasteries, which are located on the road between Cairo and Alexandria and were built to safeguard monks from Berbers and Bedouins.

Then we'll drive to [Alexandria](#) to check into your Alexandria hotel and spend the night there.

Day 5: Alexandria Tour

After breakfast, we'll leave early in the morning for Alexandria day excursions to have a fantastic day. You will begin your day at Saint Mark Cathedral and then proceed to the [Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa](#) tomb and the Citadel of Qaitbay that in 1480, the great Mamluk sultan [Qaitbey](#) began to utilize solid stones to create his castle for protection against the ottomans, that it suffered from a devastating naval attack by British soldiers, and that it was completely rebuilt anew.

We'll eat a seafood lunch at a restaurant with a view of the sea, followed by a city tour. And we'll return to Cairo at the end of your day.

Day 6: Saint Catherine tour

Take your breakfast and, we shall transfer to Saint Catherine on the sixth day in the morning. You will get the opportunity to see the Prophet Moses Springs and the [Saint Catherine](#) Convent. While seeing the region, your tour guide will teach you all you need to know about the area.

Stay the night in your hotel in South Sinai.

Day 7: Climbing Mount Sinai

After breakfast, prepare for your Sharm El Sheikh day excursions early in the morning, since on your seventh day, you will ascend [Mount Sinai](#), which is considered sacred by Jews, Christians, and Muslims as the location where Prophet Moses received the tablets containing the Decalogue. Moses received the Ten Commandments, according to the Torah, Quran, and Bible.

We will return to Cairo at the conclusion of the day.

Day 8: Final departure

We will meet you in your hotel lobby in the morning to drive you to Cairo International Airport for your last departure.
