Morning: Egyptian Museum

Because of the large amount of granite used inside the mosque, it is also known as the Muhammad Ali Mosque.

Coptic Cairo

Next, head to [Coptic Cairo](#), where you'll encounter the rich Christian heritage of Egypt. Explore the charming winding streets, ancient churches, and monasteries that have stood the test of time. Don't miss [the Hanging Church](#) (Saint Virgin Mary's Coptic Orthodox Church), an architectural marvel that dates back to the 3rd century.

Discover [the Church of St. Sergius and Bacchus](#), believed to have been visited by the Holy Family during their escape to Egypt. This area offers a serene and contemplative atmosphere, providing a unique glimpse

into Cairo's diverse history.

Take a break from your exploration to visit [the Synagogue of Ben Ezra](#) before having a pleasant lunch and transferring to [Khan-El-Khalili](#), the most important bazaar in all of Egypt,
