Take a moment to snap photos with the massive [Colossi of Memnon](#), two gigantic statues that once guarded the entrance to a now-vanished temple.

Luxor East Bank

Your trip will conclude with a delicious lunch at a local restaurant, discover in the east bank [the Temple of Karnak](#) is the largest and one of the most important temples in Egypt and the [Temple of Luxor](#) it was founded for the worship of Amun-Ra and Mut.
