Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrival Cairo- cairo day tour

A tour leader will meet you at <u>Cairo airport</u> and take you to <u>the Giza Pyramids</u>, one of the few remaining wonders of ancient history. Explore the area, including <u>the Sphinx</u>, Mortuary complex, and Egyptian papyrus institute. Visit iconic sites like <u>the Hanging Church</u>, Ben Ezra Synagogue, Church of St. Barbara, and Church <u>of Abu Serga in Old Cairo</u>. Enjoy lunch at an Old Cairo restaurant. Visit the 14th-century commercial hub, Khan el-Khalili, and spend the night in your hotel to fully appreciate its sights and sounds.

Day 2 - fly to luxor- Luxor Museum & Mummification Museum Tour

After breakfast, your tour guide will come to your hotel to pick you up. They will help you with the checkout process and then drive you to Luxor and back to your hotel.

After we pick you up from your hotel, we'll go to The Luxor Museum.

The Luxor and <u>Karnak temples</u> are just two of the historically significant locations where the artifacts in this museum were discovered. There are many different types of artifacts in the enormous collection, such as jewelry, ceramics, sculptures, and stone tablets. <u>The Thutmose III statue</u>, the artwork from the Karnak temple, and <u>Tutankhamun's</u> personal belongings are a few of the museum's most fascinating attractions.

We're heading to the Mummification Museum, where you can discover more about the fascinating practise of mummification, the background of the implements used, and the cruel treatment of the people who handled the remains. Following this educational history lesson, you will have the opportunity to explore the museum.

Day3-Luxor West Bank

We'll pick you up after breakfast and drive you to the West Bank of Luxor where your day trip will start. Situated on the west bank of Luxor, the Valley of the Kings is the necropolis of Thebes and will be your first stop. This renowned necropolis is a must-see for visitors to Luxor. This area is made up of tombs beneath Mount Thebes. Three dynasty tombs are accessible to visitors here. The top tombs to visit can be recommended by your Egyptologist guide. Once you have explored the tombs, you will arrive at the Queen Hatshepsut Temple. The two largest ancient statues in Egypt, the Colossi of Memnon, will be your next stop.

Day4- Day Trip to Edfu and Kom Ombo from Luxor

As we After breakfast today, we'll head out and make our way to Edfu and Kom Ombo. The Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek, will be visible to you. Your journey to Edfu will resume after this stop. To see the god with the falcon atop his head, you will be brought to the Temple of Horus. This recently built pharaonic temple is quite magnificent because it has been well maintained. In the evening, we will drive you to your Aswan hotel so you can check in and make arrangements to stay the night.

Day5- Aswan high dam and the Abu simbel temble

Our tour guide will pick you up from your hotel and take you on a tour of <u>Aswan</u>, where you'll visit <u>the Aswan High Dam</u>, a significant engineering achievement that has improved the quality of life for millions worldwide. The dam is crucial for Egypt's industrialization, hydropower production, and flood control. After arriving, you'll visit <u>Abu Simbel</u>, famous ancient Egyptian architecture temples, and <u>the Temple of Queen Nefertari</u>, where Rammesses II, Hathor, and Ra work together.

Day6- Visit Philae Temple and fly to cairo

We'll take you on a tour of the Philae Temple, one of Egypt's most magnificent temple complexes, after breakfast. After that, we'll ride a water taxi to Aglika's ruins, which are located south of the old Aswan Dam. This temple complex's original layout and architecture have been painstakingly preserved. It was relocated to its current location when the construction of the High Dam threatened to submerge it forever. The island's landscaping was also designed to imitate the complex's former environment. Philae rose to prominence as the center of Isis worship during the Ptolemaic Dynasty. You will be dropped off at the Aswan airport after your tour is over so you can catch your flight to Cairo. After that, you'll be taken to your Cairo hotel, where you'll spend the next

Day7- Bahariya Oasis safari Tour

We will be driven from Cairo to the stunning <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> as the first stop on our Bahariya Oasis Tour. You will continue your tour by seeing the renowned Mummies Hall, <u>The Golden Mummies</u>, and the temple of Ain El Muftella after meandering through the historic village, going to <u>the Black Mountains</u>, and stopping at the salt lake. As part of your tour, you will be driven back to your Cairo hotel for the evening after lunch by a tour guide who speaks English.

Day 8- Alexandria Ancient Adventures

Our guide will take you to explore <u>Alexandria's</u> Greco-Roman ruins, including <u>the Kom el Shoqafa</u> <u>Catacombs</u>, Serapeum, and Roman amphitheater. Enjoy Mediterranean seafood and visit the 15th-century

<u>Citadel of Qaitbay</u>. Explore the underwater archaeological exhibitions at <u>the National Museum of Alexandria</u>. Enjoy a street food tour of Egyptian cuisine, including Koshary, kebabs, and shellfish. Enjoy ice cream and treats before being transferred to your hotel in Alexandria.

Day 9- Alexandria Modern Magic- Back cairo

Our tour guide will drive you up to see the Great Library of Alexandria after breakfast and check-out. For the majority of antiquity, this ancient library served as the epicenter of learning and is still a breathtaking sight. Take a tour of the new Alexandrian Library to start the day. Next, visit the Nabi Daniel and Abu al-Abbas al-Mursi mosques, two of Alexandria's most well-known structures.

Bike down the picturesque corniche after crossing the Stanley Bridge and Montazah Palace Gardens.

We will visit Cairo in the evening and then the following morning, we will drop you off at your hotel.

Day 10- Final Departure

After breakfast, a vehicle will take you to Cairo Airport to prepare for your flight out.
