Day 1 : Arrive Cairo - Check-in

Upon your arrival at [Cairo International Airport](#), a Cairo Top Tours representative will facilitate a smooth exit process. You'll be whisked away to your hotel in a comfortable, air-conditioned vehicle, where you'll settle in for an overnight stay and be welcomed with a refreshing drink.

Optional: Your first evening is free for relaxation, or you may choose to experience the enchanting Sound and Light Show at the Giza Pyramids area.

Day 2 : Giza Pyramids & Sphinx and Sakara tour

After Breakfast, your tour leader will rendezvous with you at your hotel and facilitate your transfer to your next accommodation in a private, air-conditioned vehicle. They will assist you in ensuring a swift and hassle-free check-in upon arrival.

First, you will visit the [Pyramids of Giza](#) the most iconic and awe-inspiring structures in the world, serving as a testament to the ingenuity and advanced architectural skills of ancient Egypt.

After delving into the pyramids' construction, you'll visit the Valley Temple of King Chephren, where you'll uncover the profound mysteries of mummification in ancient Egypt. Historically, each pyramid complex consisted of a valley temple, a mortuary temple, and the pyramid as the burial tomb. Among the monuments at the site, only King Khafre's pyramid complex remains largely intact. This valley temple was used for the pharaoh's pre-burial ceremonies.

The tour of the Giza Pyramids includes a scenic journey that provides a panoramic view of all the pyramids in Giza, granting tourists the opportunity to take unforgettable photos for their memory books.

You have the opportunity to explore the open-air museum situated at the site of [Memphis](#), the former capital of the pharaohs during the Pyramid Age or the new kingdom. Here, you can admire the alabaster sphinx statue of Ramses II.

Following a delightful lunch, you'll journey to Saqqara, a site rich in Egyptian antiquities and discoveries. Here, you'll encounter the [Step Pyramid](#) Complex and King Djoser's pyramid, the world's first structure entirely built of six stacked stone tiers. You'll also have the chance to venture inside the Pyramid of Teti and visit a noble's tomb, like the Kagemni tomb.

Reaching your hotel will mark the end of your day.

In Cairo, spend the night at a hotel.

Lunch and breakfast are provided.

Day 3 : Cairo sightseeing tour

Enjoy an open buffet breakfast at your hotel in Cairo to kickstart your day.

Begin your tour with a visit to [The Egyptian Museum](#), where you'll witness the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world. Explore two floors filled with royal mummies, massive statues, golden possessions, and beautifully designed accessories of Egyptian queens. Don't miss the breathtaking treasures of King Tutankhamun, discovered intact.

Next, head to Coptic Cairo, where you'll visit the [Hanging Church](#), constructed above the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon. Explore the church of Abu Serga, housing the crypt where the holy family sought refuge. Discover the historic [Ben Ezra Synagogue](#), linked to the story of baby Moses in the Nile.

Relish a delicious lunch at a nearby restaurant, savoring the flavors of Egypt.

Continue your journey to the [Citadel of Saladin](#) and explore the Alabaster Mosque. Enjoy a stunning panoramic view of Islamic Cairo, with its mosques, domes, and minarets.

Transfer to Islamic Cairo and delve into the ancient walls, gates, and streets of Fatimid Cairo.

Complete your day with a unique shopping experience at the vibrant [Khan El Khalili Bazaar](#) in Cairo.

Optionally, consider a Nile cruise tour in the evening, enjoying a delightful dinner on board.

Day 4 : Cairo to Aswan and Embarkation to Myfair Nile cruise

Continue your tour on the East Bank, witnessing the vast [Karnak temple](#), which comprises a vast mix of temples, chapels, pylons, and other ancient buildings on the east bank of the Nile River near Luxor in Egypt. complex and the Temple of Luxor. After the tour, a comfortable three-hour drive takes you to Hurghada, where you'll be staying overnight at the Marriott Hurghada resort.
