Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara, Memphis

Next, head to the impressive Mortuary [Temple of Hatshepsut](#), one of the most iconic structures in ancient Egypt. The Temple made out of local limestone to commemorate the achievements of [Queen Hatshepsut](#) of the 18th Dynasty of the new kingdom.

Take a moment to snap photos with the massive [Colossi of Memnon](#), two gigantic statues that once guarded the entrance to a now-vanished temple.

Luxor East Bank

Your trip will conclude with a delicious lunch at a local restaurant, discover in the east bank [the Temple of Karnak](#) is the largest and one of the most important temples in Egypt and the [Temple of Luxor](#) it was founded for the worship of Amun-Ra and Mut.

After the tour, you'll return to your hotel and overnight there.
