Day 1: Arrival to Cairo and check in

Visit the <u>Bibliotheca of Alexandria</u>, once the biggest library in the world, the earliest scientific research facility in recorded history. It was established by Ptolemy I at the beginning of the third century BC and is situated in the city that bears its name, facing the Mediterranean.

While visiting Alexandria, make sure to eat some fresh seafood for lunch! the freshest ingredients are used to create it, so enjoy.

After that, a transfer will take you back to your Cairo hotel.

Day 04: Cairo to Aswan and Embarkation

Enjoy afternoon tea and the beautiful scenery along the way, followed by the Captain's welcome cocktail (smart casual attire). A fantastic dinner will be prepared onboard, and afterward, there will be disco music for entertainment.

Day 6 : Sightseeing at Edfu Temple

The largest ancient religious complex in the world, the Karnak temple complex, as well as the <u>Luxor temple</u>, should be explored. Following that, a cutting-edge air-conditioned vehicle will transport you to <u>Luxor Airport</u> so you can catch your flight back to Cairo. You will be transported to your hotel for the night in Cairo following arrival.
