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Day 1: Arrive in Cairo, Egypt

After enjoying a delicious lunch at another good-quality restaurant, you will proceed to [Memphis](#) to visit the open-air museum, which is only 20 minutes away from Saqqara. The museum houses an exhibition of statues and artifacts that remain from the ancient capital of the pharaohs, including [the alabaster sphinx](#) made out of an eighty-ton block of marble and the gigantic fallen statue of Ramses II.

Once the tour is finished, you will be transferred back to your hotel to spend the night. Breakfast and lunch will be included in the tour package.

Day 3: The Egyptian Museum, Coptic, and Islamic Cairo Trip

You will stop for a local lunch meal at a good-quality restaurant before starting your Coptic Cairo tour. You will visit the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon and be amazed by [The Hanging Church](#), one of the highlights of old Cairo. You will also visit the church of St. Sergius, which is also known as the Cavern Church. It was built above the crypt, where the holy family stayed for nearly three months, and the well from which they drank water. Finally, you will visit [Ben Ezra Synagogue](#), which is believed to be the site of the pharaoh's palace where the basket of Moses was picked up from the Nile.
