

Day 1: Arrive Cairo / Check-in

Then return you back to your camp to rest and have lunch.

Day 5: Sinai to Cairo

We will return to Cairo after breakfast, transfer you to your Cairo hotel, check in, and overnight.

Next on the itinerary is the [St. Sergius Church](#), a place of immense religious significance. This church is believed to have been built over the crypt where the Holy Family, including Jesus Christ and St. Joseph the Carpenter, sought refuge for three months.

Continuing our journey through the diverse religious heritage of Cairo, we visit the [Ben Ezra Synagogue](#) With its roots dating back to the early centuries.

As the day unfolds, we delve further into the Islamic quarter of Cairo. You'll have the opportunity to admire the [Al-Hakim Mosque](#) and explore the ancient stone-paved streets, medieval madrasas, and city gates that harken back to the Islamic era.

Cap off your tours of Islamic Cairo with a mint tea at [Fishawy Cafe](#), one of the oldest and most renowned traditional Egyptian coffee shops, as you take in the minarets of [Al Hussein Mosque](#) and Al Azhar Mosque in the oldest section of the Islamic quarter, Khan El Khalili, Egypt's oldest souk.

Then, our tour guide will return you to your hotel so you may relax there.
