Day 1: East Bank sightseeing and embarkation on the MS Nile Radamis

On your first day of touring Egypt, the tour manager from Cairo Top Tours will pick you up at the airport, train station, or any Luxor hotel and drive you in an air-conditioned car to the MS Nile Radamis Nile cruise or similar.

After enjoying a delicious buffet lunch on board, embark on an East Bank of Luxor tour with your tour guide.

First, you'll visit the magnificent Karnak Temple, which honors the sun god Amun-Ra, goddess Mut, and their son, the moon god Khonso.

Next, you'll visit the magnificent Luxor Temple, one of the most well-known temples constructed on the East Bank of the Timeless River during the New Kingdom era.

Enjoy a delicious supper on your first night on a Nile cruise ship while admiring the breathtaking scenery and a lively folklore performance.

Spend the night in Luxor.

Meals: Dinner and Lunch.

Day 2: West Bank Tours (Hatshepsut Temple and the Valley of the Kings and Queens)

You can sign up for an optional early-morning hot air balloon ride in Luxor if you'd like to attempt an exhilarating adventure.

On your Nile River Cruise, savor an open buffet breakfast in the early morning. After that, continue with your day trips around Luxor until your private driver and Egyptologist guide pick you up to begin your tour of the West Bank of Luxor and the Valley of the Kings. You will receive a thorough explanation of the development of the royal tomb in ancient Egypt when you arrive at the Valley of Kings.

See the massive, towering sculptures of King Amenhotep III known as the Colossi of Memnon, as well as the Temple of Hatshepsut, also called the Temple of El Dier El Bahari.

Following the tour, you will be driven back to the Nile Cruise by your Egyptologist guide, where you will enjoy a delicious lunch before the boat sets sail for Edfu.

You will spend the night in Edfu after having dinner.

Meals consist of breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 3: See the temples at Edfu and Kom Ombo

You will resume your package tour of Egypt this morning. Begin with breakfast, which is served on board the cruise ship along the Nile River and is prepared with fresh ingredients. The boat will next travel towards Aswan as a representative from Cairo Top Tours will accompany you to enjoy the sightseeing at the Edfu Temple of God Horus, who was the protector of monarchy and is typically portrayed as a man with two enormous wings and a falcon's head.

The cruise ship will offer you a delectable lunch before you arrive at Aswan. We will also make a stop at the historic little village of Kom Ombo. After arriving, your certified Egyptologist guide will take you to see the Ptolemaic Temple of Kom Ombo, which was constructed in honor of the ancient Egyptian crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris.

After that, you will cruise down the Nile to Aswan.

In the evening, dinner will be given on board, followed by the Nubian performance.

Dinner, lunch, and breakfast are served.

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing Tour

After a delectable breakfast served al fresco on the boat, you will be transferred to enjoy Aswan day tours. The first stop on the tour will be the magnificent High Dam in Aswan, which was constructed to regulate the Nile water during the agricultural year, making it simple to save water and produce electricity. Next, you will see one of the most intriguing temples constructed in the Greco-Roman architectural style, the Philae Temple, which was devoted to the worship of Goddess Isis. Proceed to The Unfinished Obelisk in the granite quarries, which was likely constructed for Queen Hatshepsut but was never finished.

In the evening, you will enjoy your savory lunch while sailing with your MS Nile Radamis Nile Cruise. Your dinner will also be served aboard your Nile Cruise and overnight in the amazing city and things to do in Aswan.

Day 5: The Nile cruise disembarkation

You might choose to go on our optional morning tour to the magnificent Abu Simbel Temples, which King Ramses II erected for himself and his adored wife Queen Nefertari.
