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A Cairo Top Tours representative will meet you anywhere in Cairo or Giza to begin your exciting 3-day trek in the Sinai Wadis. The journey starts early with a 5-hour drive to Sinai. Upon arrival, you'll check into a Bedouin camp before starting your trek, visiting the Palace of Abbas Pasha, the canyon of Wadi Sagar, and the granite pools of Kharazet el Shaq. The route begins at El Milga, passing through Abu Jeefa, with overnight stays at Bustan el Birka and El Karm Eco-Lodge. You'll explore Sida Nogra, Wadi Gharba, Sheik Awad, and Naqb el Hawa before returning to Cairo.
