Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival Day

After picking you up at Cairo Airport, the tour leader will drive you in a contemporary, air-conditioned car to your accommodation. You will receive assistance with a seamless check-in when you arrive.

Unwind and spend the night at your accommodation before getting ready to embark on our adventure the following day.

Day 2: Pyramids Tour

On the second day, you will start your tour by being picked up from your accommodation in the morning. You will be transported once more to continue the adventure after breakfast.

Because of their height and excellent craftsmanship, the Giza Pyramids are currently ranked seventh on the list of wonders of the world.

The Great Sphinx is a stunning limestone statue of a legendary beast with a human head and a lion's body. Its artistry is demonstrated by the fact that its original colours can still be seen close to one of its ears.

The construction of the Valley Temple lasted until the end of the Twelfth Dynasty and began under the reign of Pharaoh Sneferu.

According to ancient Egyptian history, Memphis served as the nation's capital from the Third Dynasty until the Sixth Dynasty. Memphis is hence a significant city in Egyptian history.

You will then be driven all the way back to your hotel at the end of the day.

Day meals include lunch and breakfast.

Day 3: Old Cairo tour

You will see some of Cairo's top attractions on the third day. That day is when this will begin.

One of the Middle East's oldest and most well-known archaeological institutions is the Egyptian Museum. From the earliest prehistoric times to the classical era, it is home to a vast collection of ancient Egyptian antiquities. This historical treasure trove offers a singular and enthralling window into the cultural legacy of one of the earliest civilizations on Earth.

One of the oldest military strongholds constructed during the Middle Ages, the Saladin Citadel is an important historical site in Islamic Cairo. It is a well-liked tourist destination and a great place to learn about Islamic history.

Additionally, you will be touring some of Cairo's most prominent Islamic and Coptic areas. Then, at the end of the day, you will be going back to your hotel and staying overnight.

Day 4: Fly to Luxor

You will be leaving early in the morning on the fourth day for Luxor, a city rich in culture and history. You will take a plane back to your starting point after your day trips.

With a diversified collection of temples constructed over 2,134 years, the Karnak Temple is a striking sight. Since one of the most significant ancient Egyptian religious rites took place at the Luxor Temple, it was aligned with the Karnak Temple rather than the typical east-west axis of most other ancient Egyptian temples.

After that, you'll be driven to your accommodation for the night. Day meals include lunch and breakfast.

Day 5: Luxor Tour

Your Deluxe Luxor Day Tour will begin with a breakfast that will prepare you for the remainder of your trip. Although the western valley has its own distinctive and magnificent tombs that are still under construction, the eastern valley of the Kings is more famous for its numerous royal tombs. As significant as the eastern valley, the western valley actually has twenty incomplete tombs that are only beginning to take shape.

At the end of the three-story Hatshepsut temple lies a series of columns. Statues of Hatshepsut in the guise of Osiris, the god of the dead, stand in front of the open courtyard on the top floor.

A beloved component of our culture is Memnon, a statuesque masterpiece of ancient Egyptian art. However, we think that these statues should be preserved for future generations because they are the only remnant of King Amenhotep III's magnificent burial temple. For the night, you will be returned to your hotel.

Day meals include lunch and breakfast.

Day 6: Travel to Hurghada

You will be picked up in the morning on the sixth day after finishing your breakfast. You will then check out and go to Hurghada in an air-conditioned vehicle.
After checking into your hotel, you will have a restful night's sleep.
