Day 1: Embarkation - Luxor East Bank Tours

Our staff will meet you wherever in Luxor and transport you to your Steamship in an air-conditioned car. Sudan Nile Cruise includes embarkation and an open buffet lunch on board. Afternoon excursion to the spectacular Karnak Temple complex, which was erected by numerous Kings and rulers of ancient Egypt.

Inside, you will view the temple of Amun, who was the father of gods in ancient Egyptian religion. You will be astounded at how massive the temple is, no surprise! Its construction and development lasted centuries, from the Middle Kingdom to the Ptolemaic period. You will tour the Luxor temple, erected by Amenophis III but primarily credited to Ramses II.

Enjoy your meal and sleep on the boat.

Day 2: Valley of the Kings - Sail to Esna

After breakfast, you will tour the Valley of the Kings, the New Kingdom's Theban necropolis where the Pharaohs designed their tombs to be artistic wonders. You will tour tombs such as Ramses VI's, which is one of the largest and best-preserved in the area. Take a look at Deir el-Madina, the renowned valley of the tomb decorators, before eating lunch and sailing to Esna near Edfu, where you will spend the night onboard.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

The Temple of Edfu, dedicated to Horus and Hathor, was built in the 3rd century B.C. Ptolemaic Dynasty and completed after 170 years. It is one of Egypt's best-preserved structures. Return to the boat and cruise to Kom Ombo for a stunning sunset. Visit the Kom Ombo Temple, a one-of-a-kind structure dedicated to the divinities Sobek and Haroeris.

Overnight on board.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 4: Sail to Aswan - Philae Temple

After breakfast, resume sailing the Nile River to Aswan to see the lovely islands along the Nile, including Elephantine Island, which was a commercial hub in the Nubian civilization and was known for its lush soil. Visit the Temple of Philae, where ancient Egyptians worship the wife of the God Osiris, Goddess Isis, Goddess of Magic, and the hero in the famous myth against the evil God Seth.

Enjoy lunch and an optional excursion to see the beautiful Sound and Light Show before dinner and overnight.

Day 5: Disembarkation

After your delicious breakfast, you will be taken to any place in Aswan after disembarking from the Steamship Sudan Egypt Luxury Nile Cruise.

Itinerary option 2: (Eternal River 5 Days Aswan to Luxor) - Day 1: Embarkation - Philae Temple

[Cairo Top Tours](#) tour leader will meet you and transfer you by a private vehicle till you enter your [Sudan Nile Cruise](#), after embarkation, you will have your open-buffet lunch on board then you will examine the magical [Temple of Philae](#) dedicated to the worship of Goddess Isis. Discover the area and browse the gift shops before getting back to the vessel for a tasty dinner and overnight aboard the boat.

Itinerary option 2: (Eternal River 5 Days Aswan to Luxor) - Day 2: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Sail to Kom Ombo while you have your English morning Tea after the delicious breakfast onboard, when you arrive, you will have an exceptional time wandering in the [Temple of Kom Ombo](#) on the Nile bank, dedicated to two deities, Haroeris and Sobek but mostly known as the Sobek temple. Enjoy your lunch in the magical atmosphere while sailing to Edfu where you will visit the [Temple of Edfu](#) and admire its huge architectural view. Sail to Esna with the relaxing music in the background and dinner aboard your steamship.

Itinerary option 2: (Eternal River 5 Days Aswan to Luxor) - Day 3: Luxor East Bank Tours

After having breakfast, you will visit the grand [Karnak Temple](#) located on the East Bank of the Nile in Luxor (ancient name Thebes), which is a complex of three main temples and ruins. Lunch is served on board then you will have an evening visit to [Luxor temple](#) where the production of three great Pharaohs resulted in such a gigantic worship place from the ancient ages, Amenhotep III, Ramses II, and [Queen Hatshepsut](#). Dinner and overnight stay in Luxor aboard your Nile cruise.

Itinerary option 2: (Eternal River 5 Days Aswan to Luxor) - Day 4: Valley of the Kings

After having breakfast, you will start your [West bank tour of Luxor](#) to visit the magnificent rock cut-tombs of the New Kingdom Pharaohs, known as [the Valley of the Kings](#), where they built their tombs far away from

the tomb robbers, it is also thought that the valley where the workers and craftsmen who built the necropolis lived in the valley known as [Deir el-Madina](#), to keep the place as a secret, they lived there, and they were also buried there. Lunch and dinner will be your way to daydream while feeling the warm breeze of the Nile and overnight in Luxor.
